



This year, Films for Future takes place from 1 to 30 November 2025 at 10 different locations in Zurich. Films for Future expects around 10,000 visitors to attend over 100 events. The festival will show films that linger in the memory and address pressing issues of our time, while also offering hope. From the climate crisis and environmental protection to social justice and visions of the future. Since 2012, the Films for Future Festival has been bringing films, people and ideas together – for a sustainable and just future.
